### Launch and Haul-Out

• A check for \$60 should be made out to Conanicut Marine Services and enclosed with the complete entry form. This check is required for the entry to be considered complete.

An SYC team will be available to assist in the launch and haul-out and in organizing the tow to SYC. It is approximately 1.7 NM to SYC and is a very pleasant sail for those who might wish to take advantage of the day. Trailers will be parked at a local site. Arrangements will be made to get the trailers to and from the site. Trailers will be marked with tape and a number to aid in haul out.
